

Guidelines to defining network connections

Works
Works means any fittings that are used, or designed or intended for use, in or in connection with the generation, conversion, transformation, or conveyance of electricity; but does not include any part of an electrical installation.
(Ref: The Electricity Act)

Point of entry For our purposes of these clarifications this is the point at which the service mains (Overhead O/H) or (Underground U/G) enters an installation structure.
(Ref: AS/NZS3000:)

Electrical Installation
(i) In relation to a property with a point of supply, all fittings beyond the point of supply that form part of a system that is used to convey electricity to a point of consumption, or used to generate or store electricity.
(ii) In relation to a property without a point of supply, all fittings that form part of a system that is used to convey electricity to a point of consumption, or used to generate or store electricity.
